Please note that appointments will be allocated consecutively commencing on the 16th April, bookings for the 23rd will not open until the 16th has been filled and so on.

### Phase 1b Criteria

- Health Care Workers
- Adults 70 years of age and over
- Younger adults with underlying medical conditions
- Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islanders 55 years of age and over
- Defence, Police, Fire, Emergency Services and Meat Processing personnel
