SHIRE PRESIDENT'S UPDATE

Last month the Shire held six community workshops encouraging the community to participate in and contribute their ideas for the Strategic Community Plan and Phase 3 funding of the LRCI Program. These workshops were well attended and we are continuing to gain valuable feedback from the community. The closing date for feedback is the 16th August 2021.

LRCI Phase 2 projects have commenced which include Flax Mill - camp kitchen upgrade and electrical upgrades, Swimming Pool - additional shade, 24hr public access gym, new flooring and disability access improvements, Town Hall - repairs to lesser hall flooring.

The Shire has also secured additional grant funding for:

- Minor repairs to our Community Housing units through the Department of Communities.
- A new 1.8m high vermin proof fence at the airstrip funded through the Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources.
- Funding towards Stage 2 of the football oval lighting upgrades through the Department of Local Government Sport and Cultural Industries.
- Technology & Digital Inclusion grant through the State Library of Western Australia.

The Shire is also in the early stages of relocating the library to the Boyup Brook Community Resource Centre (CRC). Permission has recently been granted from the State Library of Western Australia to proceed with the relocation. The Shire will keep the community updated as we transition this service from the Shire Administration building to the CRC.
