\$915,062 in Federal Government funding awarded to four major Shire projects including more than \$650k to upgrade the Town Hall Precinct

Council have selected four priority projects under Phase 3 of the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Program.

Priority projects funded under LRCI Phase 3

- Town Hall repairs and renewal \$665,062
- Repair works on five Community Halls \$120,000
- Sandakan Park Playground revitalisation \$100,000
- Increased disability access at the Boyup Brook Community Swimming Pool \$30,000

Projects to be completed by 30 June 2023. Council have also resolved to allocate an additional \$457,531 from the LRCI Phase 3 Extension to

- Boyup Brook Cemetery upgrades \$357,531
- Recreation Precinct upgrades \$100,000 These projects are expected to commence in July 2023.

The funding allocated will enable much-needed repairs and refurbishment of the Town Hall (encompassing the Main Hall, Lesser Hall and surrounding carpark). This significant project will include drainage upgrades, painting and landscaping, and improved accessibility.

Council have allocated \$120,000 for repair works on five community halls: Mayanup Hall, Tonebridge Hall, Dinninup Hall, Wilga Hall, and Kulikup Hall. The Shire will work closely with each hall committee to ensure projects are tailored to meet the current and future needs of each building.

The Sandakan Park Playground will receive an initial \$100,000 in LRCI funding awarded to assist in revitalising the playground. The Shire is currently working to secure further funding to compliment this initial investment and expand the scope of works. \$30,000 has been allocated to enhance the accessibility of the Boyup Brook Swimming Pool to improve disability access to one of the town's main sporting and

recreation facilities. Automatic doors will be installed to improve inclusive access to the facility and allow greater participation in recreation activities for all residents.


In July 2023 the Shire will be eligible to access an additional \$457,531 in LRCI funding under the Phase 3 Extension. Whilst construction on these projects cannot commence until the second half of next year, \$357,531 has been earmarked for major upgrades to the Boyup Brook Cemetery along with \$100,000 for the Recreation Precinct. It is anticipated community consultation on these projects will commence in early 2023, and upgrade plans will be made available for public comment in mid-2023.

FIREBREAKS WITH RANGER DONNA

It's time to start planning your fire mitigation so it is not left to the last minute.

- 1. Book in your contractor for October if you get your breaks and paddocks done mechanically by a dozer or slasher. Don't miss out on a spot in their diary!
- 2. Poisoning needs to start now when winter growth is young and small, so check out what is available with our local farm suppliers.
- 3. Talk to your local brigade if you think a planned burn is the way to go and get some wise advise and assistance if required.
- 4. Start that yard tidy and get ready for spring. Green waste is free to drop off at the transfer station. Opening times are on the front page.
