Flax Mill Caravan Park and CMCA

Caravan Parks in Western Australia are regulated under the Caravan Park and Camping Grounds Act 1995 and Caravan and Camping Regulations 1997. In April 2022 Council resolved for the Shire to enter into a Management Agreement with the CMCA (Campervan & Motorhome Club of Australia Ltd) to manage the Boyup Brook Caravan Park. The CMCA is the largest Recreational Vehicle (RV) club in Australia, with more than 70,000 members, and currently operates parks in all Australian states other than WA. They promote these parks through their online website and monthly magazine to members.

The arrangements for the Flax Mill Caravan Park were made to preserve the flax mill heritage, attract more visitors to town to support the local shops and businesses, and to allow the caravan park to be financially viable. It is all part of a much larger work that Council is doing with other Warren Blackwood Shires to promote the vibrancy of our towns and to retain and attract more services to them.

One of the requirements under the Act and Regulations that the shared management agreement assists the Shire to meet, is for a permanent caretaker to be resident on site, and that accurate records are kept of all people who stay in the park. The CMCA organises for one of its members to be a voluntary caretaker on site and take bookings through an online system. The Shire carries out all maintenance and cleaning and receives the majority of the booking fees. The regulations also state that 'a person is not to allow an animal under his or her control to become or cause a nuisance to any other person at a facility'. Heavy penalties apply. Please be respectful of the volunteer caretaker's obligations.

The Flax Mill Caravan Park is located on freehold land and is included in a 'Special Use Zone' that sets aside land to facilitate special categories of land use. In this case, it is used to set land aside for a caravan park and the historic Flax Mill buildings, including the land down to 5m of the river level. This is quite distinct from the 'Public Open Space Zone' that exists over the Music Park and recreation grounds which sets aside these areas for public open space.

- Access to the two story dormitory building is currently restricted due to safety concerns as the building has deteriorated and requires some renovation works to make it safe.
- The scale models in the Scutching Shed are available for viewing in their current location at no charge. Please organise this through the Shire.
- The second story hall in the Scutching Shed remains available for use by visitors and residents. As is the case with all Shire facilities, please arrange bookings through the Shire.
- To ensure compliance with Caravan Park and Camping Acts and Regulations and insurances, access to the river is available at the Music Park behind the stage with improved accessibility.
- The Music Park is a great place for everyone to enjoy with shade for picnics and plenty of space to walk your dog.
- The Lions Park is also a lovely shady area on the riverbank with picnic facilities.
