Heat Stress

To help you stay healthy after hot weather or extreme heat:



continue to drink plenty of water so your body can get back in balance



open doors and windows with locking screens to let cool air through your home to cool it down



🕻 get plenty of rest



if you feel unwell, make a time to see your doctor



contact family and friends to see how they coped and to check if they need help



think about the things you could do differently so you are better able to cope next time it is very hot



make any changes to your home so it will be more comfortable next time there is hot weather or extreme heat

If you have severe symptoms, dial triple zero (000) to call an ambulance, alternatively see your doctor or ring Healthdirect on 1800 022 222



We are currently within PROHIBITED BURNING TIMES and this means that all open air burning is **PROHIBITED** at any time! This includes any fires big or small or ACCIDENTAL. Rideon mowers and slashers are common causes of paddock fires so ensure you have contacted your Shire or local Fire Control Officer **BEFORE** you decide to jump on board.

They will check that the weather is going to be suitable, that you have adequate fastresponse water supplies and whether it is a suitable action to take to maintain your paddock or block. FINES do apply even if the fire is accidental! Don't be a WALLY and stay FIRE safe!

TOTAL HARVESTER and VEHICLE MOVEMENT BANS

may be declared at any time. This means you are **PROHIBITED** to use any vehicle with a **COMBUSTION** engine 'off-road' during any period specified in the ban.
