Dog and cat registrations are now due

The Shire sent out registration renewals at the end of October for cats and dogs whose registration expires in 2023. The registration period runs from 1 November through to 31 October each year, regardless of the initial date of registration. If your pet is registered with another Shire, current registrations can be transferred between most local Shires in Western Australia. Please remember that it is important your contact details are kept current with the Shire of Boyup Brook and microchip database, and we ask you to inform us as soon as possible of any change of ownership, loss, or change of address. Please note that registration and microchipping are two different things. All dogs and cats must be microchipped as well as registered with the Shire where they live. Failure to do so could incur a fine.
