

## Works In Progress

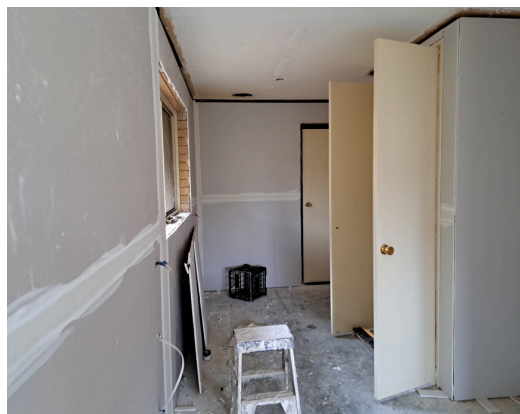
Refurbishment work has officially commenced at 16A & 16B Forrest Street, marking the beginning of a significant upgrade to these Shire owned Community Housing units. The modernisation project aims to enhance the living conditions for residents by transforming the outdated interiors into contemporary, comfortable spaces. Key features of the refurbishment include brand-new kitchens designed with modern appliances and fixtures to improve functionality and convenience, new plasterboard and paint to refresh the interiors, and the installation of new flooring which will provide a durable and functional foundation that complements the overall design.

When completed, these upgrades will not only improve the quality of life for current residents but also increase the longevity of the property. This project reflects a commitment to providing safe, comfortable, and modern housing that meets the evolving needs of our community.

Flu and COVID vaccines are still available. If you would like one, please call the practice to book an appointment.

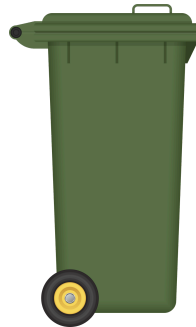

The Emergency Information & Bushfire Control 2024/2025 Booklet has been sent out with Rates Notices. If you do not receive a rates notice and would like one, they are available from the Shire Administration Office, the CRC or the Medical Centre. The booklet contains important information about being prepared for bushfire.

The Shire's Firebreak and Fire Hazard Notice has also been issued to property owners. Under the Bush Fires Act (1954), all owners and occupiers of land in WA must establish and maintain firebreaks. A firebreak is a strip of land cleared of all inflammable material like wood, leaves, and grass that could catch fire. It must be accessible to fire trucks, with vegetation cleared to a maximum height of 50mm. Firebreaks cannot end in a dead end, they must be continuous.
