On the topic of pets, please ensure that you have thought of your animals this summer. There has been an increase in animal nuisance calls, including neighbours cats in yards, howling barking dogs, and straying stock. If you have animals it is YOUR responsibility to ensure they are not a nuisance to your neighbours or community. Failure to do so may incur an infringement, a court imposed penalty or your animals seized and detained. Please ensure your animals remain on your property, have plenty of water, feed, and in regards to pets, have enough companionship and exercise to curb excess noise and efforts at escaping.
