


Seating to be installed along Abel Street

We've recently been awarded a \$5,000 Streets Alive grant thanks to Main Roads. Following consultation with the community we'll be installing four bench-style seats along Abel Street at useful points where our community congregate, such as outside the Pharmacy and Medical Centre.

The Rylington Park Scholarship, founded by the Rylington Park Management Committee Inc., embodies Eric Farleigh's vision of engaging and nurturing Boyup Brook's youth in agricultural endeavours. Supported by the Shire of Boyup Brook, which continued its commitment after assuming management of Rylington Park farm, the scholarship aims to sustain the agricultural heritage of the community. Help prevent the spread of PSHB this winter

DO NOT move wood out of the quarantine areas. Polyphagous shot-hole borer (PSHB) does not move far on its own but can travel long distances when people move firewood. Buy your firewood where you burn it.

DO NOT burn any PSHB infested wood. This can cause PSHB to leave the material, increasing the risk of further spread.

Important information to note:



All potential candidates are required to complete a mandatory candidate induction before nominating. Details are available on the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries website.



Candidates and donors also have an obligation to disclose any election-related gifts received or promised in the six months leading up to polling day.



As per the Local Government Act 1995, all candidates must follow the Shire of Boyup Brook Code of Conduct for Council Members, Committee Members and Candidates. This applies throughout the election period and continues if elected. Breaches of the code may result in formal complaints and action under the Act.
