SHIRE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

By now most of you will have received your annual rates notice. This year Council have adopted a 4.5% increase in rates which will allow the Shire to build up the building maintenance and equipment reserves. This budget includes stimulus funding from the state government which is allowing us to improve community facilities, including new lighting at the sports oval, with funding also coming from community groups and the Shire.

Swimming pool upgrades will be funded by Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) funding along with improvements and upgrades at the Flax Mill Caravan Park. The budget also includes building and equipment upgrades at Rylington Park. Some changes to Fees and Charges have been made to better reflect community benefit and encourage utilisation of facilities such as the Town Hall and Lesser Hall with these being now free to use (bookings are still required). The number of rural tip passes has now been increased from 20 to 40.

I would like to congratulate St John Ambulance Boyup Brook for recently being awarded Sub Centre of the Year 2021. Our local volunteers are a dedicated group of people who provide an invaluable service to our community.


Australia Day Awards





The Winter Grading Program will continue during September.
