Have your say about the future of Boyup Brook

Community involvement in Council planning is essential for key projects, strategic planning and policy development to ensure informed decision-making, transparency and timely and effective communication with the community and key stakeholders.

The Strategic Community Plan (SCP) is the lead document in a framework that guides everything we do at the Shire and ensures decision making is in line with community expectations. All Local Governments in WA are required to have a ten-year SCP developed with the community to outline their broad vision and aspirations.

The community engagement process provides Council with a clear direction and understanding of the community's well-being, aspirations, issues, and priorities over the short and long term.

For the first phase of the process we have provided Postcards asking three questions for the community to give feedback to Council about their priorities for the next four years; this includes what the community could look like in 10 -15 years, and what are the most important issues that the community may face into the future. These postcards will be sent out with the newsletter and will be available at businesses around town.

Please ensure your completed postcard is submitted to the CRC or the Shire Administration Office by Friday 31 August. The feedback received on these will inform the second stage of consultation in September, where there will be further engagement opportunities with an online survey and face to face workshops.

Council will be working with an experienced independent consultant, Margaret Hemsley from LG People and Culture, to develop a user-friendly plan and foster the collaborative development of goals, objectives, and underpinning strategies.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT EXTRAORDINARY ELECTION IS BEING HELD ON 17 OCTOBER 2020
CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS - ROLL CLOSURES: 5.00pm FRIDAY 28 AUGUST 2020

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government election on Saturday, 17 October 2020 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the district of the Shire of Boyup Brook.

Residents, you are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5.00pm on Friday 28 August 2020. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll, a claim for enrolment can be made to any Divisional Returning Officer of the Australian Electoral Commission in Western Australia. Forms are available from all post offices or the Western Australian Electoral Commission and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer by 5.00pm Friday 28 August 2020.
