# FIRE INFORMATION & FIREBREAK NOTICE



## Restricted Burning Times (PERMITS REQUIRED)

**9 October to 20 November** in each year, both dates inclusive and

**1 March to 30 April** in each year, both dates inclusive.

## Prohibited Burning Times

**21 November** in each year to **28 February** the following year, both dates inclusive.

## Period during which mobile fire fighting power unit required when harvesting

**15 November to 15 April** (the responsibility to supply the unit being that of the landholder).

## Automatic harvesting and total movement ban CHRISTMAS DAY

## Burning of garden refuse or lighting of open air camping or cooking fires is banned

**21 November to 28 February** in each year, both dates inclusive.

**Firebreaks must be installed by 30 November.**

## NOTE

- Restricted Burning Times and Prohibited Burning Times may be varied due to seasonal changes. Variations will be advertised in a local newspaper and on the Shire's website. It is the responsibility of owners and occupiers of land to ensure they are aware of any variations.
- The Department of Fire and Emergency Services may declare a total fire ban. Such a declaration overrides any other authority. Total fire bans are advertised on the Department's website and broadcast on ABC radio. Information can also be obtained on the Department's Total Fire Ban Information Line 1800 709 355.
