# DRAFT STRATEGIC COMMUNITY PLAN

The Draft Strategic Community Plan is now available on the Shire website and is open for public comment. Please provide your feedback by email shire@boyupbrook.wa.gov.au or post Shire of Boyup Brook, PO Box 2, Boyup Brook WA 6244. Comments close Monday 16 August 2021.

The Strategic Community Plan outlines the transformational journey Boyup Brook will make over the next 10 years. The plan has a number of key priority areas. The key priority areas are:

- Identify and acknowledge community aspirations and articulate a shared vision for the future
- Coordinate decision making and build close working relationships with other organizations in the community
- Provide a long-term focus for the delivery of services and facilities by the Shire and other organizations working with and within the community
- Identify Council's strategic priorities for the Boyup Brook Community

#### COMMUNITY PROJECT PRIORITIES

The Shire has received advice from the Australian Government that Boyup Brook will receive \$915,000 in Phase 3 of the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Program in January 2022. There is also approx... \$500,000 available for community projects from Rylington Park (which may be available to leverage further grant funding). The Shire would like to give you the opportunity to participate and contribute to local decision-making processes. You are invited to attend one of these community workshops to have your say about how we might achieve the goals of the SCP and to discuss potential projects.


The Annual Electors Meeting will be held in mid-July. You will be notified once the date has been confirmed.

Winter grading and drainage works will be commencing in July and conducted on a circuit.




Maintenance grading will be carried out on an as needs basis following verification by a Shire Officer.
