- Signed Statutory Declaration
- Shire Officer sighting cat's ear tattoo and confirming sterilisation

Important Information

- All cats aged six(6) months or over MUST be registered, desexed and microchipped.
- You MUST notify the Shire of Boyup Brook of any change in particulars contained in this application including the sale, change of ownership or death of the cat.
- Cat registration expires on 31 October each year.
