Fees Payable

For new dog registrations received after 31 May and before 1 November, the fee payable is 50% of the fee that would otherwise be payable.

- The fee payable for registration of a Working Dog (a dog that is bona fide used in the droving or tending of stock) is 25% of the fee that would otherwise be payable.
- The fee payable for registration of a Declared Dangerous Dog or Restricted Breed Dog is \$50.00. Concessions do not apply to these fees and registration must be renewed annually.

Information as per Dog Act 1976

- All dogs aged three (3) months or over MUST be registered and microchipped. Failure to register a dog may result in a penalty under the Dog Act 1976.
 - You MUST notify the Shire of Boyup Brook of any change in particulars contained in this application including the sale, change of ownership or death of the dog.
 - Dog registration expires on 31 October each year.
 - You must have a collar on the dog with the registration number tag. It is recommended each dog also has a tag on which is inscribed the owners name and address. These are obtainable from the RSPCA, pet shops and other sources.
 - Definition of a WORKING DOG for concessional registration purposes is 'Dogs used for droving or tending stock'.
 - Definition of a PENSIONER FOR concessional registration purposes are Aged Pension, Invalid Pension, Widowed Pension, Supporting Parents Pension and Carer's Pension. A copy of the pension card id required when registering the dog.
 - Maximum number of dogs to be kept on any premises is two over the age of three months (dispensation can be given to keep more than two dogs in some cases, but subject to written request to the Shire and certain other conditions being met).
 - To register a dog under sterilised concessional rates an owner or agent should either have a veterinarian's certificate or be prepared to sign a Statutory Declaration to that effect.
 - Dogs must be kept on a lead in all public places except designated dog exercise areas.
 - Dog owners must provide means on their property to effectively confine their dog.
