<p>Cats Exempt from Registration A cat that is in the custody of any of the following is exempt from registration -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cat Welfare Society Inc, trading as 'Cat Haven' • Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (RSPCA) WA Inc • A management facility • A veterinary clinic or veterinary hospital <p>A cat that is in foster care is exempt from registration if the cat has been placed into foster care by either the Cat Haven, the RSPCA WA or by SAFE (Saving Animals From Euthanasia), and providing the cat has not been in foster care for more than a total of 12 weeks.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In addition to the cat registration number tag, each cat must also have a tag on which is inscribed the owners name and address. These are obtainable from the RSPCA, Pet Shops and other sources. 2. Definition of a PENSIONER for concessional registration purposed as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Aged Pension - Invalid Pension - Widowed Pension - Supporting Parents Pension - Carer's Pension A copy of the pension card is required when registering the cat. 3. Maximum number of cats to be kept on any premises is two over the age of six months (dispensation can be given to keep more than two cats in some cases, but subject to written request to council and certain other conditions being met). 4. Cat owners are also reminded that cats six months and over must be sterilised, microchipped and registered at all times. Council also requests that cat owners inform the Council immediately of any change of ownership, address or death of a cat. 5. Failure to register a cat may result in a penalty under the WA Cat Act. 6. The owners name and address must be displayed on the cats collar.
